

**Environmental Fellows Program
Capstone Project Authorization Form**

EFP students are required to complete a Capstone Project.

The Capstone Project has three requirements:

- 1) It must be a research project, internship, or practicum connected to the environment that results in degree credit at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. EFP projects are typically supervised or overseen by a faculty member.
- 2) The Project must be approved by an EFP advisor
- 3) The finished Project is to be submitted to the School of Earth, Society, and Environment (SESE) prior to graduation.

Once you have made a plan for the first requirement (EFP students typically organize a Capstone project through their Major department) use this form to get official approval from an EFP advisor. It can either be brought to an EFP advising appointment or sent to:
